

Theater Faculty, Program Director and Technical Director (Two Positions)

Tabor College is seeking two candidates for theater faculty, with one serving as Technical Director and one as Program Director. The Program Director is responsible for artistic vision and implementation of theater production and instruction at Tabor College. Other responsibilities include directing annual music production, one major stage play, and additional theater productions as faculty load allows; teaching theater-related courses, such as Intro to Theater, Theater Appreciation, and directing and acting courses; recruiting new students to the college to participate in theater programming; and hiring personnel for and supervising all matters of production for each performance. Responsibilities for the Technical Director include teaching theater courses, acting as scene shop supervisor, overseeing use of performance spaces including those in the Center for the Arts, ensuring proper and safe use of all performance components, designing sets for productions, acting as lighting designer and/or master electrician for productions when schedule allows, mentoring student designers/technicians, assisting with departmental functions when needed (special events, season planning, budgeting, advising, and so on), and overseeing/executing scenic painting and construction of sets and props (including hiring, training, and supervising student crews).

Qualifications:

- Master's in field required, terminal degree preferred.
- Commitment to teaching and service in the context of a Christian liberal arts college is essential
- A creative approach to innovation and program development highly desired
