

## **Tabor College**

### **Head Volleyball Coach**

**Description:** This position directs all aspects of leading Tabor's intercollegiate volleyball program including recruitment, retention, coaching, scheduling, team travel, fundraising, and budgeting.

**Specific Duties:**

- Develop and instruct student athletes in volleyball techniques and strategies in preparation for and during athletics competition
- Contact scout, and build relationships with recruits in compliance with NAIA and KCAC guidelines
- Ensure a commitment to the academic success of volleyball student athletes, including monitoring academic performance, attendance, and social behavior
- Provide on-site coaching in games and practices, including organization and implementation of yearly and daily practice schedules
- Assist in ongoing mentoring relationships with players including faith and character development
- Formulate scouting reports, statistical breakdowns, and opponent video breakdown
- Build and sustain positive relationships with student-athletes, parents, alumni, faculty, staff, and the campus community
- Provide individualized instruction to players before and after practice
- Manage the scheduling of events including the game and travel schedule
- Provide leadership to off-season training including strength and agility training and position skills
- Participate in fundraising and development events and be highly visible in the community
- Provide leadership to the implementation of the plan for integrating faith into the volleyball program
- Managing budget – purchasing equipment and apparel, submitting requisitions and other reports, etc.
- Recruiting – DB management, coordinate with admissions and financial aid, complete recruiting reports as requested
- Hire, supervise, develop, and evaluate two graduate assistants
- Manage scholarship budget – work with Director of Athletics and FA office in order to prepare estimates and official scholarship offers to recruits as well as complete and submit scholarship reports as requested
- Commitment to a coaching philosophy/style consistent with Christian principles and high personal integrity and sportsmanship standards

- Be aware of students that are struggling academically and collaborate with student success for support
- Follow protocol in regard to the implementation of institutional policies
- Maintain a professional appearance, attitude and manner of communication
- Maintain regular office hours
- Be aware of Tabor College in respect to: history, philosophy, mission, conduct, character, employee policies and procedures, academic programs, student activities and organizations, student profile, cost/fees and admissions requirements and financial aid program
- Other duties as assigned by the Director of Athletics

**Qualifications:** A Bachelor's degree and experience in coaching intercollegiate volleyball required. A Master's degree is preferred. Experience in recruiting college athletes preferred.

**Department:** Tabor College Athletics currently sponsors 19 sports and is a member of the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference as well as the National Association of Inter-Collegiate Athletics.
